**Friday, January 20, 2012**

**1:00-2:00 p.m.** Rabbi Artson's lecture, *Almighty, No Way: Process Theology and Embracing the God You Already Know* is for interested members of the community and will be held at Beth El.

Rabbi Artson will talk about process theology and answer questions from participants. A box lunch will be provided. There is no fee, but prior reservations were required for lunch.

**7:00 p.m.** Kabbalat Shabbat services at Beth El followed by an Oneg Shabbat. Childcare available with prior reservation.

**Saturday, January 21, 2012**

**9:30 a.m.** Shabbat service in the main sanctuary. Our scholar-in-residence, Rabbi Artson, will give the D'var Torah, *Commanded by Love*. The formal installation of Rabbi Greyber as Beth El's rabbi will take place during the Torah service. A kiddush luncheon will follow. Child care will be available from 9:30 till 12:30 for children ages 5 & younger (Tot Shabbat 10:15-11:15). There will be programming for students K-5th grade 10:15- 12:30 (including Jr. Congregation & Jr. Jr. Congregation).

**4:30-5:30 p.m.** Beth El high school students are invited to a Seudah Shl'ishit and discussion *No Holds Barred: A Teen Forum* with Rabbi Artson and Rabbi Greyber at Beth El. There is no fee, but reservations were requested.

**6:30 p.m.** Beth El members and special guests are invited to celebrate Beth El's 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and the installation of Rabbi Greyber at the Levin JCC. We'll begin the evening with appetizers and music, and then proceed to havdalah, dinner and more festivities. A short film featuring the special people and events that make Beth El special and a history display chronicling Beth El's 125 years in Durham are highlights of the evening.
